Exemptions

If you are a homeowner, you may qualify for property tax exemptions in addition to homeowner's exemption. Exemptions are available for seniors, senior freeze, persons with disabilities, returning veterans, veterans with disabilities, home improvements, and longtime homeowners. We encourage you to contact your local assessor's office to inquire if you are eligible to apply.

Estate Planning

We would like to prepare our clients for potential estate tax changes. As we move into the new year, it is important to review estate planning goals and plan for the future. Illinois currently has estate tax on estates worth more than \$4 million dollars. The Federal estate tax applies to estates worth more than \$13.61 million dollars in 2024, however has the potential to be lowered by Congress starting January 1, 2026. This reduction could lead to more estates being taxed in the future. Please indicate if you would like to discuss tax strategies in preparation for these upcoming changes.
